**ESSAY OR POETRY ENTRY - GUIDELINES** – PLEASE KEEP A COPY, IN CASE YOU ARE A WINNER!

**ESSAYS:** 250 – 300 words **Please be positive and life-affirming!**

**POETRY:** 8 - 10 lines **Students may choose their poetry style.**

**THIS BIBLE VERSE MUST APPEAR AS THE TITLE OF THE ESSAY OR POEM:**

**“... your light must shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your heavenly Father.” Matthew 5:16**

Students may write about one or several of these: **expectant mother & preborn child**  
**terminally ill person      physically or mentally challenged person**

They may include people they know personally or someone they have read about and admire.

**Essays or poems about fictional people will not be accepted.**

**Students should include these points, when writing:**

The value of those they have chosen to write about, and why their right to life must be defended.

How Christians may assist them – physically, emotionally, and spiritually.
