**"So faith, hope, and love remain. . . but the greatest of these is love."  
1 Corinthians 13:13**

If students include statistics, quotes, etc., the source of these **must** be listed in parentheses.

Students **MUST:** Select one/more of these topics, suggest acts of love (charity), and explain WHY.

- \* **expectant mother and preborn child: Why student opposes abortion**
- \* **stem cell research: Why student opposes human embryo research**
- \* **terminally or mentally ill person: Why student opposes euthanasia or assisted suicide**

Students may mention actual people they know personally or admire, but not fictional characters.
