### ART ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

#### GRADES 4-6

**HAND-DRAWN ART SIZE:** 8.5 x 11, landscape orientation

**MUST** be original; no tracing.

Dark or vivid colors are preferred, since images done in pastel colors might not be seen clearly.

<u>DIGITAL ART SIZE</u>: 8.5 x 11, landscape orientation Must be original work, with no copyright.

Students may use public domain/free sites.

# ESSAY ENTRY REQUIREMENTS GRADES 4-6

THE TITLE OF THE ESSAY. PLEASE DO NOT INCLUDE
ANY OTHER BIBLE VERSES:

"Do not neglect to do good and to share what you have; for with such sacrifices, God is pleased."

**Hebrews 13:16** 

375—425 words IF YOU MENTION FACTS OR FIGURES IN YOUR ESSAY, INDICATE THE SOURCE, IN PARENTHESES.

Students MUST share how they would apply their Christian faith to "...do good and share what they have..." with one or more of these:

- \* Mothers in unexpected pregnancies, before and after birth: How to assist them, including supporting them, if they decide to surrender the baby for adoption.
- \* Those with physical or mental challenges: Why they are valuable and what it means to be a caregiver to them.
- \* People who are terminally ill: The good they still bring to others, and how we can give them hope and comfort.

Students may mention an actual person (not fictional) they know or of whom they are aware.



## POETRY ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

GRADES 4-6

THIS BIBLE VERSE AND CITATION MUST APPEAR AS
THE TITLE OF THE POEM. PLEASE DO NOT INCLUDE
ANY OTHER BIBLE VERSES:

"Do not neglect to do good and to share what you have; for with such sacrifices, God is pleased."

**Hebrews 13:16** 

10-12 lines; students may choose their poetry style and may mention <u>actual persons</u> (not fictional) in their poem.

**Students** MUST compose a poem about one or more of the people in these circumstances:

- \* Expectant mother and preborn child
  - \* Parents who are adopting a child
- \* People who are physically or mentally challenged
  - \* People who are terminally ill

Students may include these details:

- \* The challenges faced by these people
  - Their emotions and hopes
- \* How others could "...do good and share what they have..." to assist them
