ART ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

GRADES 9- 12

HAND-DRAWN ART SIZE: 8.5 x 11 or larger, landscape orientation

<u>MUST</u> be original; no tracing.

Dark or vivid colors are preferred, since images done in pastel colors might not be seen clearly.

DIGITAL ART SIZE: 8.5 x 11, landscape orientation Must be original work, with no copyright.

Students may use public domain/free sites.

"Do not neglect to do good and to share what you have; for with such sacrifices, God is pleased."

550-600 words IF YOU MENTION FACTS OR FIGURES IN YOUR ESSAY, INDICATE THE SOURCE, IN PARENTHESES.

* Which faith-based agencies could assist these people?

Students MUST compose a poem about

* People who are physically or mentally challenged—to oppose euthanasia and assisted suicide
